



Introduction

Given the historical trends in the development of American university music curricula up until the first part of the twentieth century, academic music libraries generally focused on European art music and grew by adding many of the same monographic and printed music titles to meet the needs of scholars and students. However, in the mid-twentieth century curricula began shifting into new areas as programmes expanded in response to the globalisation of the field of musicology and an increased focus on popular music and interdisciplinarity. To address this, libraries strove to match their collecting to curricular






